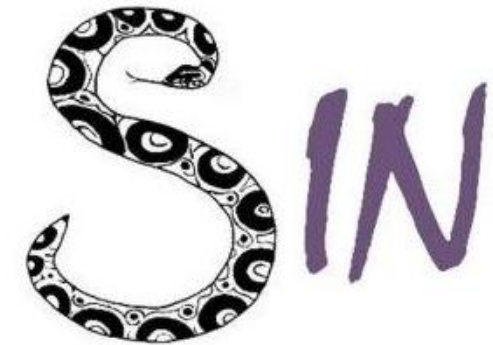

ABORIGINAL and TORRES STRAIT ISLAND (ATSI) SEX WORKERS

SIN is committed to best practice service delivery to the ATSI sex work community in South Australia. SIN has worked with marginalised communities for over 25 years and we take great pride in promoting inclusivity and solidarity.

EVENTS- On the last Wednesday of every month SIN hosts **SINners Dinners**, which provides a free meal to Street Based Sex Workers. It is an opportunity to get to know other street based sex workers, receive support, debrief, and to find out what SIN has on offer for you. If you require transport we can arrange to pick you up. Street based ATSI workers are always welcome.



So, what is sex work?

Sex work is the exchange of sexual services for money, goods, services and favours.

There are different sectors of the sex industry; street based sex work, brothels, massage parlours, escorting, private sex work (from home or a private residence) and touring. Subsequently, sex work can take place in a brothel, a client's home or vehicle, a massage parlour or a sex worker's home. Sex work can also be opportunistic, for example, sex in exchange for goods, or sex in exchange for somewhere to live or sleep. SIN supports workers from all sectors of the sex industry - if you identify as a sex worker, or you think you may have done sex work, give us a call - we're your organisation.

SIN provides a **safe space** for all those who identify as sex workers past or present- men, women, brother boys and sister girls.
