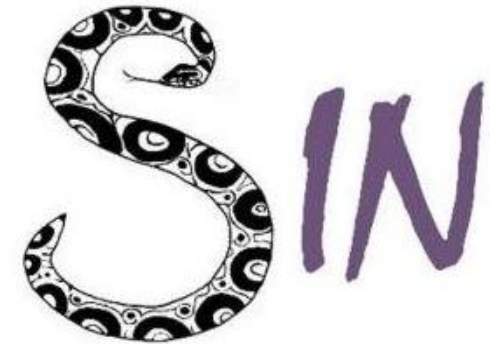

SIN is a peer based organisation. The Street Outreach workers have a background in Sex Work and Intravenous Drug Use. We strive to improve sex worker's lives by promoting the health, rights and well-being of sex workers. We provide information, education, support & referral services both onsite & as an outreach service. We pride ourselves on being a service by sex workers for sex workers.

About us: we provide a Street Outreach Service on Wednesday nights from 7.30pm to 11.00pm and on Friday nights from 7.30pm to 11.30pm. We provide all street workers with free condoms and lube. We also provide CNP service on outreach as well.



On Outreach we have on offer: free condoms in a range of sizes and flavours, lubricant in sachets or bottles, sponges (on request), sexually transmissible infections handbooks, and educational literature.

As part of our **Outreach Project** we also offer a **Clean Needle Program** which includes: 1ml syringes in 10 and 40 packs as well as boxes of 100, 2ml water for injections, skin cleansing swabs, cotton wool, plastic spoons, and sharps waste containers. We will take away your full sharps waste containers on outreach at your request. For safer injecting information please ask us for a copy of our Handy Hints book.

At the end of every month we meet as a street based sex worker community for a meal and a soft drink. This is called **Sinners Dinners** and it's also free. It is an opportunity to get to know other street based sex workers, receive support, debrief about work, and to find out what SIN has on offer for you. If you require transport we can arrange to pick you up. From now on the dinners will be held at different locations within the street working area (around Hanson Rd).
