### Feast Queer Youth Drop In.

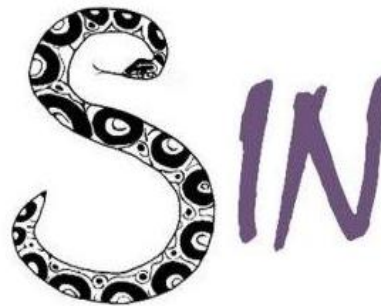

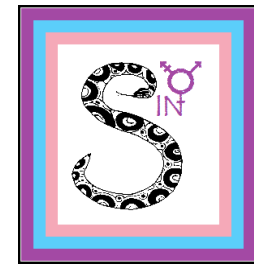
